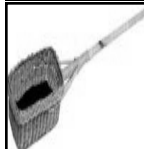

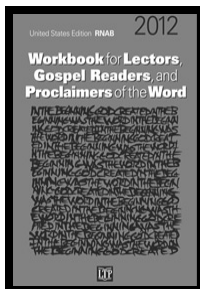

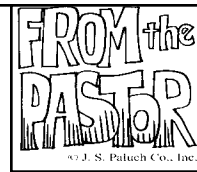

Dear Parishioners and Visitors to Our Lady of Guadalupe,

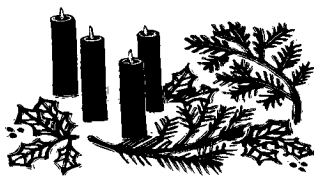
